Essence	ESSENCE	 Observation Reading Effectively QWERTY 	What must something have in order to be that thing? For instance, a slide just needs to allow you to slip from one point to a lower one; a tree must have a trunk and branches.

Keep on Track	Track	 Observation Reading Effectively QWERTY 	Keep a clear idea of the Question you are trying to answer, or the thing you are looking for. Don't digress or get side-tracked.
Key Features	KEY Features	 Observation Reading Effectively QWERTY 	Key features are the main things that describe something or distinguish it from other things. They start where Essence stops.
Look OUT	OVER UNDER THROUGH	• Observation	A reminder to look over the top of things, look under them and even through them (and, if you can't look through it, you could look behind it).
MORE Information	MORE INFORMATION Memory Observation Research Enquiry	• QWERTY (Wonder)	Think about where you can find information to use in your wondering (or other thinking): what you can remember, see, or find out about (either by independent study or asking people).
More or Move?	MORE?	 Observation Reading Effectively QWERTY 	 keep looking in the same place or develop deeper understanding of a topic
P!C	P.F.C PROSS INTERESTING	• QWERTY	Whenever you are considering something, bear in mind the pros (i.e. advantages or positive benefits), cons (disadvantages or drawbacks) and any other elements that are interesting.

Quizzical	© Nikajica J	MemoryReadingEffectively	A reminder to check your knowledge, understanding or memory of something by quizzing yourself.
REF	REF Review Evaluate Feedback	 Memory Reading Effectively QWERTY (YaY!) 	Review what you have done so far. Evaluate how well (or not!) it is working. Feedback into what you are doing, so that any necessary improvements can be made as you go along.
Remember, Research, Remember	Remember Research	 Reading for Understanding Memory 	Use your memory of what you know to streamline the research process and help embed new knowledge in long-term memory.
Six Honest Men	6 Honest Men O O O O O O O O O O O O O O O	 Reading Effectively QWERTY (to direct your thoughts) 	The six important questions you might need to answer: Who? What? Where? When? Why? How?
Weigh to Go	WEIGH To GO	 Reading Effectively QWERTY (Rank) 	Rank and evaluate key features, options or information.
Whose Views?	Whose Views?	 Reading Effectively QWERTY 	In your planning, consider other views (as well as, not instead of, your own!). How/why might those views differ?
Wrap and Remember	WRAP E REMEMBER	 Remember Reading Effectively QWERTY 	Use existing systems or techniques that you already know (and have made a point of remembering) to save you time in future.
